  - Summary of the learning experience
  - Demonstration or evidence of learning and growth
  - Connection to your Learning Plan
  - Connection to a Learning Goal (Personal Qualities, Communication, Quantitative Reasoning, Empirical Reasoning, Social Reasoning)
  - Audience: Your Advisor, Another Staff Member + peers, mentor, parents by invitation
  - Professional Attire

### Exhibition Categories:

1. Learning Plan
  - Should include an explanation of edits and the process
2. Internship or LTI Process
  - Internship Project
3. Projects
  - Individual projects
  - Advisory projects
  - Rotation projects
4. Rotation Courses (including math)
  - Please plan to demonstrate learning or show evidence during your exhibition
5. Advisory Work
  - Current events log
  - Evidence of contribution to advisory projects (ie. door decorating)
  - Autobiography
  - Independent & Group Reading
6. Post High School Planning
  - State Exams Taken or Prepping For (SBA Math & ELA)
  - College Entrance Exams Taken or Prepping For (ACT/SAT)
  - Scholarship Notebook (Seniors)
  - FAFSA (Financial Aid - Seniors)
  - Resume/Letters of Recommendation
  - Career and/or College Research

  - What have you learned most about?
