







Bulldog Media Assignment

1. Begin a new file.
2. Click on stage with black selection tool.
3. Go to properties and make stage a school color.
4. Find the text tool and drag a window on the stage.
5. Type: Bulldog
6. Highlight "Bulldog" and go to text properties.
7. Drag the size to fill the screen.
8. Select a school color to stand out against the background.
9. Your screen should look something like the image to the right.
 
10. Now select the text.
11. Go to Modify, Break Apart to Separate the word into it's separate letters.
 
12. These separate letters are automatically symbols.
 
13. Now go to Modify/Timeline/Distribute to layers.
14. This automatically takes the letters off layer 1, creates separate layers for each letter and names the layer after the letter that went there. For example the letter B is now on layer B and is a symbol.
 
15. Right click on B, create a motion tween and drag the letter to a new position.
 
16. You can curve the line immediately after doing this to modify the motion path of the symbol b.
 
17. You can go through and create individual motion paths for each of the remaining letters.
18. If you point to any place on the tween and move the letter, that becomes a new key frame for your motion path.
19. Final step, at the end of the animation insert a bulldog image, size it to the stage, turn it into a symbol and tween it. Then adjust its alpha in properties. Have it start at 0 and finish at 100. This makes it appear on stage.
