

Bulldog Text Project

Create a Photoshop print document in landscape format 11x8.5

Find a high resolution view of a bulldog and insert on that page.

Cut out background so bulldog is isolated and nearly fills frame.

Insert new black fill layer below image {option-Delete w/blk}

Now create combined black + image. Select both layers and use (Cmd-Shift-Option-E) on Mac.

Do a file save as and save file to desktop as Displacement.psd

On top combined image layer press Command L to open levels.

Drag output levels from right corner to between 110 and 120 & click OK

Get your text stored into memory.

With text tool draw a window to include entire image area

Tutorial settings: ariel, 12pt, smooth, left align, white.

Go to window, select Character menu

Change leading to 10

Paste Text and fill page with no spaces

To make text wrap, select text layer then Filter, Distort, Displace

Rasterize Text. Set H Scale to 5, V Scale to 5, Stretch to fit, repeat edge pix

Open saved displacement.psd at this point

Change blend mode of text layer to overlay

To make image brighter copy the displacement layer until happy

Add a color gradient layer and adjust if desired.
